### WHERE ARE WE GOING?

Our riding week will be based in and around Niseko. Located under 2 hours from Sapporo airport in the Hokkaido province of Japan.

This place needs no introduction as the record snowfalls of the past 2025 winter were all over the news. This place coined the term Japow.

But its not about just one resort, this week is about visiting as many places as possible. From Niseko to Moiwa to Rusutsu and even days in the smaller out of town resorts for a truly crowd free local experience. All on ground transport is obviously included for this.....more itinerary information later in this pack.

### WHO CAN ATTEND?

ANY level of recreational rider is welcome on our courses.

This is not some hardcore powder hiking and riding week, plenty of other providers do this.....our trips are about enjoying going riding, getting our SBC top tips to ride better and have a laugh and a few beers with other like minded people.

Of course we will ride Japow, but we ain't spending 4 hours hiking to get it! We'll be riding all the terrain Japan is famous for from the trees to pizza box chair lifts.

The way we run our riding progressions means that any recreational rider is welcome.

## WHERE DO I STAY?

### WHAT'S THE ACCOMMODATION LIKE?

Our SBC riding week apartments are located in Kutchan.

Kutchan is 5 mins outside Niseko village. It's a working village/ town which is where pretty much all of the resort workers stay. The bars and restaurants are way cheaper because of this and way less touristy. A more authentic Japanese town.

Our modern apartments do have full kitchen cooking facilities as you would expect. But our itinerary will see us being out most evenings for food. But if you prefer to stay in and relax then you have the option to make your own food and chill.

Unlike other companies, we do not cram people into our accommodation. You WON'T be sharing 4 to a room with us.

Accommodation will be 2 per bedroom. Couples are obviously allocated a room together. Bedrooms have under bed storage or wardrobes and living rooms, baths, showers and obviously the all encompassing Japanese toilet that needs no introduction....if it does need an introduction, then you're in for a treat with the warm wind option!

### SINGLE OCCUPANCY

We will have limited amount of single rooms for this trip, which will be on a first come first served basis. Obviously it will cost more. If this is something you want to add please let us know for a specific price.











### THE DATES

### **DATES FOR WINTER 2026**

We have the following riding week dates for this coming winter:

**JANUARY 11TH - 18TH** 

MARCH 1ST - 8TH

Please note the above dates are the arrival and departure dates ie the days that you will be arriving and departing Sapporo.

We have a limit of only 8 people per course so please get in touch to secure you place.

If you are a group of 4 or more looking for a week away and these dates don't work for you, let us know and we can tailor a bespoke package for your group.

### **BOOKING A COURSE**

Booking is really simple, you tell us the week you intend to come and if we have space then we pencil you in.

Then a non-refundable deposit of £300pp is required to secure your place on the week with the balance being paid 6 weeks prior to arrival. Or you can pay in full at the time of booking which we prefer as it saves a lot of hassle.

You then book your flights on the specified dates and let us know both the arrival and departure times. We can then arrange the transfers.

Then during the week prior to your arrival we will email you our arrival PDF detailing all the information you need to know about meeting at Chitose airport.

We will obviously help you in regards to flights and anything else you need to know along the way.









## MORE INFORMATION

### **FLIGHTS:**

These are NOT INCLUDED in the riding week fee. You will need to book your international flights to Sapporo (Chitose) airport. This is a popular airport for both major and local airlines and is a direct hub from Europe as well as a transfer airport from both Tokyo Haneda and Tokyo Narita.

Again more information regarding matching flight times and transfers will be sent to you upon booking.

### **90 DAY TOURIST VISA**

Arriving as a "tourist" means you can spend up to 90 days in Japan. For our UK/EU clients you currently have free visa on arrival. For clients from other countries please check the current requirements for your country.

We will keep everyone booked on the week with us updated on any rule changes regarding visas.

### **AIRPORT TRANSFERS:**

These are included in the price. Your transfer will be from and back to Sapporo (Chitose) airport on the dates above.

More information regarding the transfers will be supplied when booking onto the program.

### LIFT PASSES:

All lift passes are included for every resort we visit including the night skiing session. Should you wish to ride on your

### **MONEY IN RESORT:**

There are plenty of cash points in and around town. However, Japan still prefer the use of cash. So please have the ability to withdraw cash whilst you are with us.

### THE ITINERARY

### THE ROUGH COURSE ITINERARY:

Our planned trip will be 8 days with us in Japan which include the arrival and departure days. Below is an idea/overview of the schedule.

This is obviously subject to a bit of tweaking depending on the weather and snow conditions.

**DAY 1**: Arrival at Chitose Airport in Sapporo. We will have a group transfer picking everyone up and taking the 1.5 hour transfer to our Niseko/Kutchan base.

**DAY 2 TO 6**: We will spend these 5 days riding around all the different resorts the area has to offer. This will include riding all of Niseko ski village, Hirafu, Hanazono, Annupuri. One of the days will have a full day trip to Rusutsu and take a ride through a theme park!

We will also have at least one day further afield (maybe 2) exploring some of the lesser known resorts such as Furano and Kiroro - just to get away from the main crowds.

**DAY 7**: We will take this as a day off after 5 days of riding. Group choice will be to do something touristy and visit some local sights and then in the evening we will have a night skiing session in and around Hirafu. Of course you can choose to ride today as well if you are not feeling to tired.

**DAY 8**: Today see you venturing back to Chitose Airport ready to fly back to home or to carry on your stay with some extra time exploring the sights and wonders of Japan.

### **NIGHT SKIING SESSIONS:**

On one of the evenings and potentially we can save this to the last evening - we can end our trip with a night session. Night sessions are so different here in Japan. The snow can actually be better that the day especially if its stops snowing in the evening. Surprisingly the snow fresh and soft and not icy and hard like European night skiing. If you have one, pack a clear lense.

### **EVENINGS OUT:**

Evenings will consist of food and beers in our favourite local bars and restaurants . We will also have an onsen evening so pack your swim stuff. These are totally optional so if you prefer to go back to the accommodation and crash then you can.



# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Snowboard/Snowsports Coach are trading names under All Mountain Training SLU - an Andorran registered company - from herein referred to as "Us" and "We". You will be referred to as the "client". All applicable under Andorran Law.

Terms and conditions for our Mountain Riding Week Course.

- 1. You the client must be safe and medically sound to travel and to be in a winter resort and have appropriate insurance cover for Andorra. We will not accept any clients travelling against medical advice and you must state this in the booking form you receive from Us. We can not be held responsible for any costs/loss/damages incurred for failure to declare this.
- 1a. If applicant is not of this standard then they can be removed from the course at any time without refund. This will be solely at the discretion of Snowboard Coach if we feel that the candidate is restricting the learning of other students who have met this standard.
- The application will only be accepted and secured provided:
  The application is accompanied by a £300 non-refundable / transferable initial deposit.
- b) The booking confirmation is signed and returned.
- c) The client unconditionally accepts these terms and conditions of booking when confirming via email that a place on the course is required.

- 3. The remaining balance of your course fee must be received in full by Us at least 6 weeks prior to the course start date.
- 4. If payments are not made within 7 days of these deadlines then We reserve the right to re-allocate you're place without refund.
- 5. All changes to bookings must be received in writing by email. Any changes will incur administration costs to cover our costs.
- 6. All courses require a minimum number of clients to run a full program. If numbers aren't met a reduced schedule of hours, as detailed in the info pack, will be in place.
- 7. All clients must be insured for our courses. We advise every client to buy insurance AS SOON AS YOU CONFIRM YOUR BOOKING WITH Us. Please do not wait until the week before you travel.
- 8. Cancellation: in the event of cancellation by the client the deposit paid WILL NOT BE REFUNDABLE/TRANSFERABLE. If paid in full then the balance minus deposit will be refunded except when:
- a) Client cancels within 6 weeks of the course start date NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.
- 9. We strongly recommend that all clients embarking upon ANY of our courses take appropriate insurance which covers both cancellation and curtailment and course reimbursement/cover.

- 10. Proof of insurance or similar will be required prior to attending the course.
- 11. We will refund appropriate monies (pro rata) if the decision is made by Us to cancel all or part of the training program.
- 12. No monies will be refunded by Us in the event of an injury sustained whilst participating in ANY of our courses, where injury leads to missed sessions, curtailment of the course; then in this instance it is necessary to make an insurance claim. We will provide the necessary receipts.
- 13. If the venue of the course is adversely affected by snow, weather, force majeure or any other circumstances beyond our control that cause cancellation of any/all parts of our course and package offered NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN. Again We insist on a suitable insurance policy as detailed in point 7.
- 14. In the event of the above in paragraph 13: You, the client, agree that We cannot be held responsible for refunds.
- 15. Any client found under the influence of alcohol or drugs during course contact time (ie a training session) will be removed from the course immediately with no refund given.
- 16. In the event that an applicant is refused/unable to train on the basis of paragraph 1a, 12, 13 or 15 you, the client, agree that no monies will be refunded.
- 17. You, the client, agree that except for death or personal injury arising through the negligence of Us, We shall not be liable for any loss or damage arising whether in respect of death, bodily injury, illness suffered or contracted, loss, costs, damages or expenses incurred.

- 18. It is the clients responsibility to ensure that all accommodation, transport and any other facilities provided or organised by Us, are treated with respect and appropriate consideration as if their own.
- 19. We will not be responsible for any damage caused by you, the client. You, the client, will be held liable for any costs incurred in such a way and will agree to settle any costs immediately to 'make good' any and all damage caused.
- 20. In the event of any arrest or infraction between the client with the local Police in relation to drink, drugs or ANY circumstance that see's YOU the client arrested/detained or removed from the country. We will not be held responsible. We will stand by the decision of the enforcing agency. Again no monies will be refunded.
- 21. In the event of point 20; Our limited responsibility is to ensure that the client is given contact with the British Embassy.
- 22. As an applicant to be a client on a course or package organised by Us, whether applying by telephone, email or letter you agree to abide by these conditions when confirming your booking with us, irrespective of whether you have signed and returned the requested booking form.
